Then we will conclude the list of non-HKBU students who have completed at least 80% content and issue the certificate of participation accordingly. Highly appreciate it if you could communicate the **requirements and timeline of certificate attaining** with learners from your institution. To provide a high-tech and engaging learning circumstance, we will arrange a **synchronous session** for all *FutureLearn* learners to explore our award-winning 'Trail of Integrity & Ethics' developed using Augmented Reality technology.

HONG KONG BAPTIST UNIVERSITY Centre for Holistic Teaching and Learning

Brief Description of a Small Private Online Course (SPOC) on Teaching and Learning (*Facilitating students from different parts of the world to learn together online*)

The full course, "Teaching University Students" is a credit-bearing course that all research postgraduate (80%) students of Hong Kong Baptist University (HKBU) must complete successfully.

We have developed a SPOC on *FutureLearn* to accompany the course to conduct it in a flipped classroom setting. This SPOC enables 80% students who would take up teaching duties in the near future to learn about key concepts like Outcomes-based Teaching and Learning (OBTLE), Learning Theories, Strategies for Effective Teaching via videos, quizzes and graded tests.

By inviting non-HKBU 20% students to join this SPOC, we aim to provide more opportunities for students from different institutions and/or different parts of the world to learn together online. Students are encouraged to participate actively in the SPOC's discussion forum and exchange ideas with their fellow students.

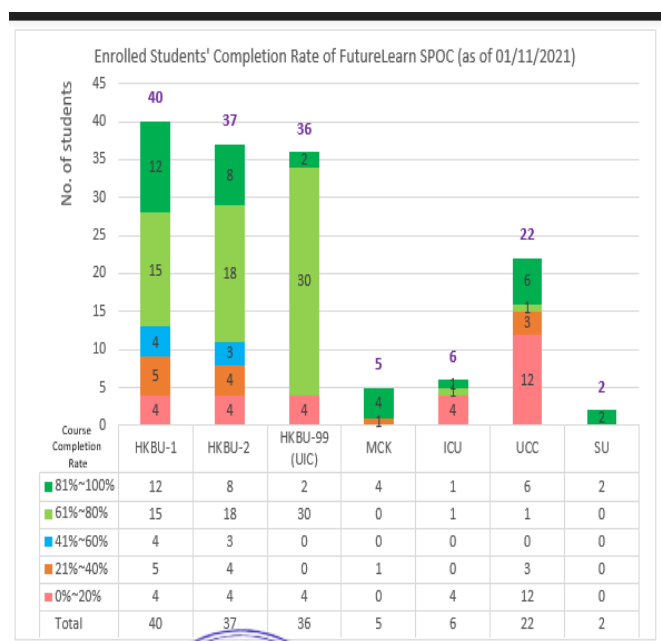
The SPOC is designed to be completed in 3 weeks, and it is scheduled to start in the Week of 11 October 2021. HKBU students are expected to finish the readings and related task and activities in the SPOC within the first three weeks of their studies. This will help prepare them to have a good grasp of the basic concepts on teaching and learning.

Non-HKBU students participating in the SPOC are expected to engage with activities therein during the period from 11 October to end-November so that all students in the SPOC will interact and learn together online. A certificate of participation will be issued to all non-HKBU students who have successfully completed 80% or more of the SPOC activities.

The invitation to join the *FutureLearn* SPOC will be sent to interested non-HKBU students by 11 October 2021.
