### 1. REPORT OF THE SCHOLAR SUPPORT PROGRAMME (SSP) FOR THE YEAR 2019-20

Marian College Kuttikkanam (Autonomous) successfully completed the Scholar Support Programme as part of the 'New Initiatives in Higher Education' of the Department of Higher Education, Govt. of Kerala. This was the second year of implementation of SSP in the College.

For the academic year 19-20, the programme was set in motion with the meeting of SSP coordinators held at Loyola College, Trivandrum on 14<sup>th</sup> of June 2019. Subsequently at the College level, a committee was formed for the purpose of implementation SSP programme.

Marian has four government aided undergraduate programmes eligible for support under SSP. These are B Com, BBA, BCA and BSW programmes. All the first year and second year students of these programmes were eligible for the admittance into the programme.

Hence a meeting of all the class advisors of these eligible batches were held on July 1<sup>st</sup>, 2019 to discuss the modalities of implementation. Following decisions were made in the meeting:





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- The weakest students shall be selected for the programme
- Students that show no interest in such support programmes, whether the student is weak or not, shall not be included.
- All teachers would give list of the students in MS Excel format within one month after the conduct of first internal assessment results to identify the poorly performing students.
- A list of interested teachers who would function as mentors will be identified by the coordinator.
- All the sessions by external mentors will be conducted on Saturdays.
- All the classes by internal mentor for English subjects shall be conducted subject to the free time availability as only B Com students would need this.
- All the other sessions shall be conducted between 3.30 to 4.30 pm by the mentors considering the fact that most of the students are hostlers and they might leave for home on Saturdays.
- A WhatsApp group shall be created for the smooth coordination of SSP programme.

### DISCUSSION

While analyzing the results, the following points emerged:

1. Second year students received more benefit from SSP than the first years.
2. Girl students are more likely to benefit from SSP than boys.
3. For programmes like BSW, SSP is relatively less needed as their attendance is low for the programme but their results of examinations are at par with other streams.
4. Students from SC/ST background needs more individualized attention as most of the students who have failed even after SSP initiative are from these categories.

However, even semester results also need to be analyzed for further comments.

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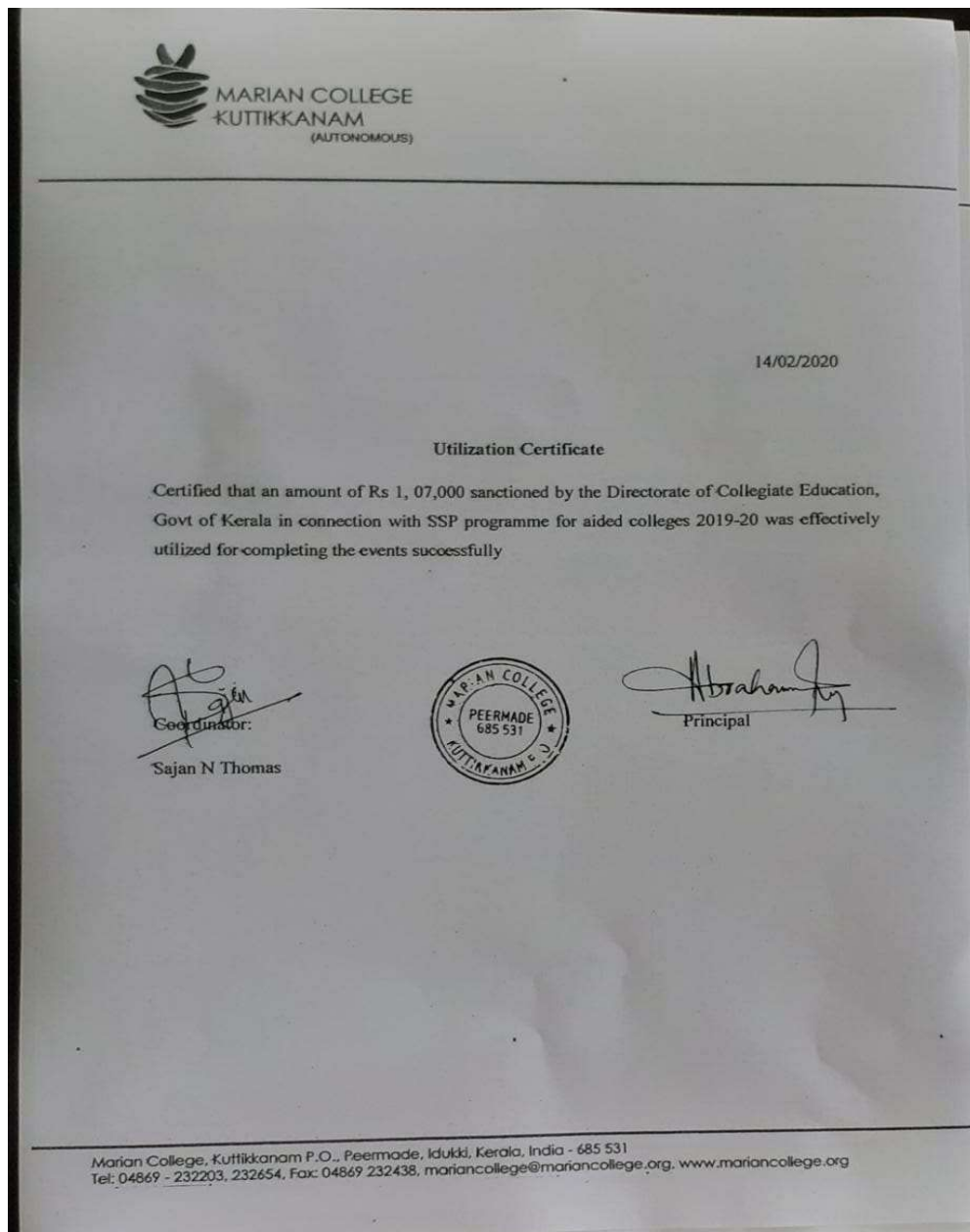
