ACADEMIC YEAR 2019-2020

Introduction

Braving the mobility restrictions due to the onslaught of the pandemic Covid -19, the College was successful in completing the evaluation process of the final UG and PG batch of students. Examinations were conducted across the state in 13 different centres and in the Union Territory of Lakshadweep. For students who were caught in foreign countries and states outside Kerala simultaneous examinations were held in online mode. Students were given the option to choose a centre adjacent to their place of residence. Question papers and answer books were taken to each centre by the teams of faculty members appointed by the College. Faculty members were assigned to oversee the conduct of examinations in these centres. Some of the practical examinations were, however, held in the College itself in offline mode after the lock down was lifted.

Setting of Question Papers

The question papers were generated from the question bank with the help of the the software named SmartE. The teachers in charge of each course were entrusted with the task of preparing question banks for each course. The teachers entrusted with vetting of the question bank were asked to give a general comment on the quality of the question bank. Moreover they were asked to give a feedback on any specific questions which required improvement/modification.
