## Student Admission and Support

- College website(**www.mariancollege.org**) was revamped to facilitate the admission process and witnessed an increased traffic to the site.
- Library facilities were made fully online with the usage of KOHA LMS

### Examination

- MOODLE LMS was already being used in our college as an e-learning resource sharing mechanism by the faculty. In addition to that, this year **Continuous** Assessments were carried out in a proctored environment through MOODLE.
- **IQAC** team, led by **Dr. Binu Thomas** conducted many trainings for the staff and students to equip them with online exam conduct using MOODLE.
- Even though the new mode of exams where enthusiastically taken up by the students and faculty members, MOODLE service was disrupted many times, due to the simultaneous access of large number of students. This issue was resolved by migrating to a **Cloud** based MOODLE hosting service offered by **BITNAMI LLC**.
- A portal named **SMARTE** was developed in-house under the guidance of the office of the Controller of Examinations for **Question Bank Generation**.
- **ROVAN** EMS was deployed for carrying out the final tasks in examinations.
