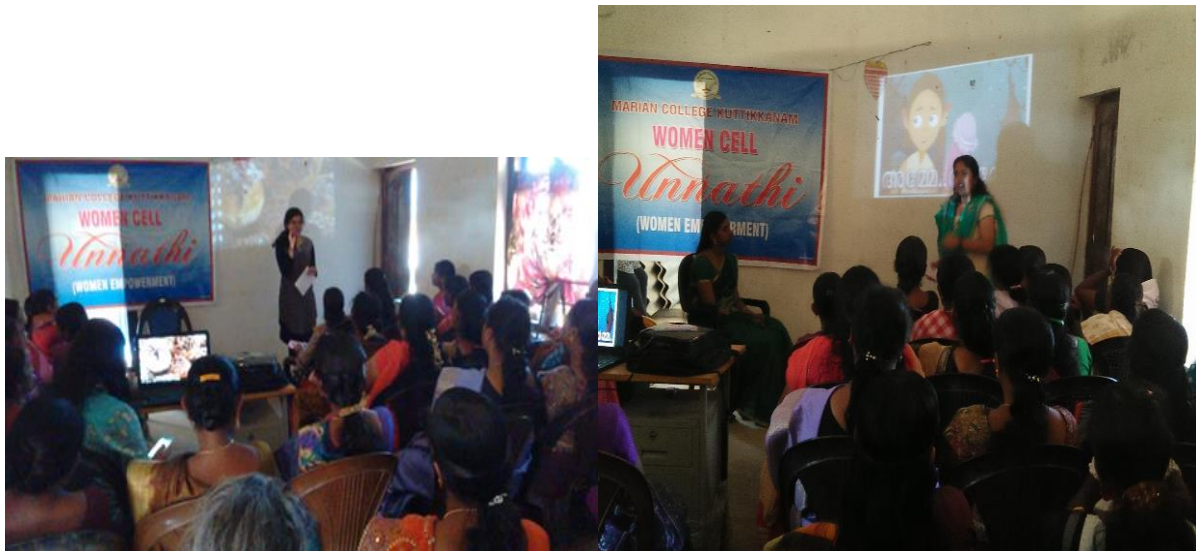


The tie-up with the Kerala Women Development Corporation was an important milestone in the journey of the Women Cell.
