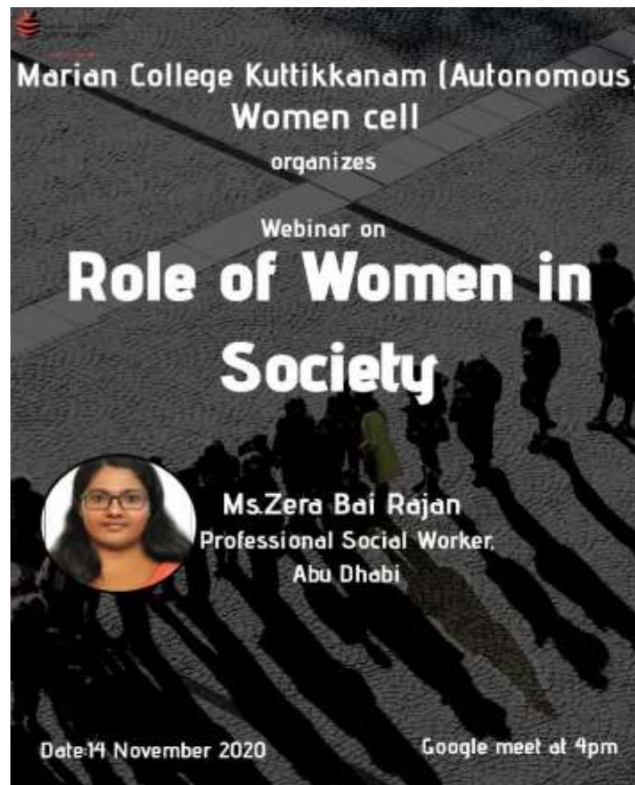

Inauguration and Webinar

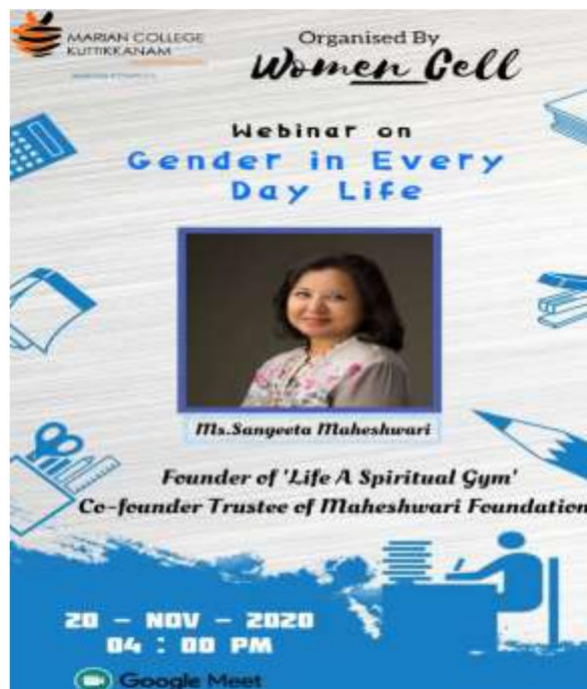
Women cell organized webinar on “Role of women in Society’ on 20 November 2020 by Ms Zera Bai Rajan. She spoke about the global role of women as caretakers, conscience, farmers, educators and entrepreneurs. The role of women in society has ensured the stability, progress and long-term development of nations. She also spoke about women, notably mothers, play the largest role in decision making about family. She said that the modern society and workforce are filled with powerful women who play their leadership roles in offices in a very impactful and efficient manner. Women are in powerful positions in various large-scale companies. Working outside doesn’t mean women do not do household chores.





Webinar on Gender in Everyday Life

Women cell organized a Webinar on '**Gender in Everyday Life**' on 20 November 2020 by Ms Sangeeta Maheswari, Founder of Life, a spiritual Gym, Co-founder Trustee of Maheswari Foundation. Why are we so insistent that women and men are different? Ms Sangeeta Maheswari spoke about how society divides people into feminine women and masculine men. Gender and Everyday Life explores gender as a way of seeing women and men as not just biological organisms, but as people shaped by their everyday social world. Examining how gender has been understood and lived in the past, and how it is understood and done differently by different cultures and groups within cultures. Gender and Everyday Life illustrates gender with a range of familiar and contemporary examples: everything from nineteenth century fashions in China and Britain, to discussions of what Barbie can tell us about gender in America, to the lives of working women in Japan. She also highlighted the role of Gender in development. It is a way of looking at how social norms and power structures impact on the lives and opportunities available to different groups of men and women. Around ninety students from various batches participated in this webinar.
