
7.1.4. Construction of Tanks and Bunds

Bunds are constructed on the campus in order to harvest and store the rainwater. There are two large water storage bunds on the campus that can store up to 2 crores and 71 lakhs litres of water respectively. About 50 lakh liters of water from the surface is saved by this measure. These reservoirs also add to the scenic beauty of the Marian campus.




Reservoir 1 located near the boys hostel with a capacity of storing 2 crore litres of water. It will make the campus self-sufficient with water supply without any external water source.






A display board with the details of reservoir 1
