2. DISTRIBUTION OF STUDY MATERIALS AT GOVT. LP SCHOOL, KOZHIMALA

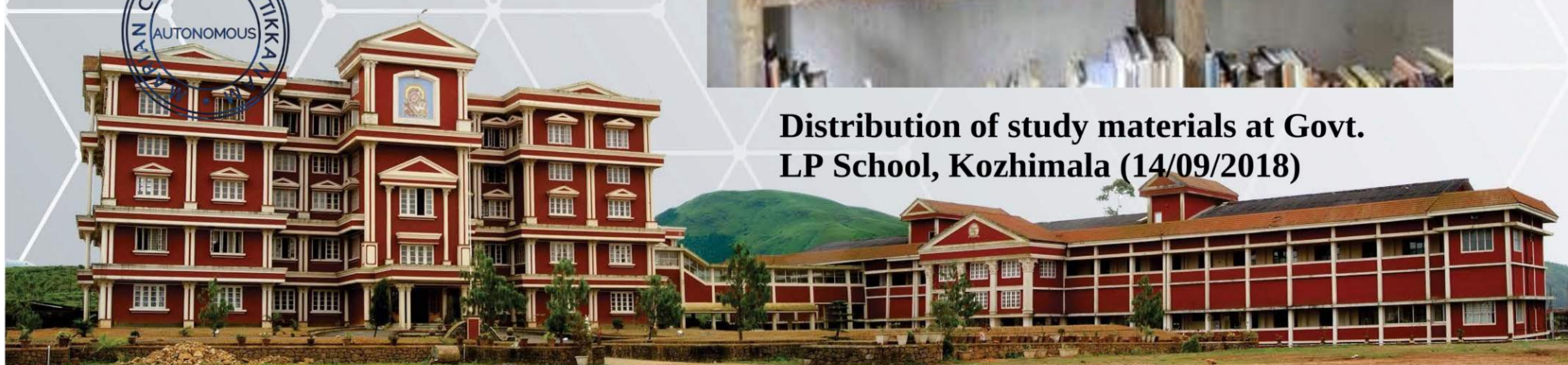

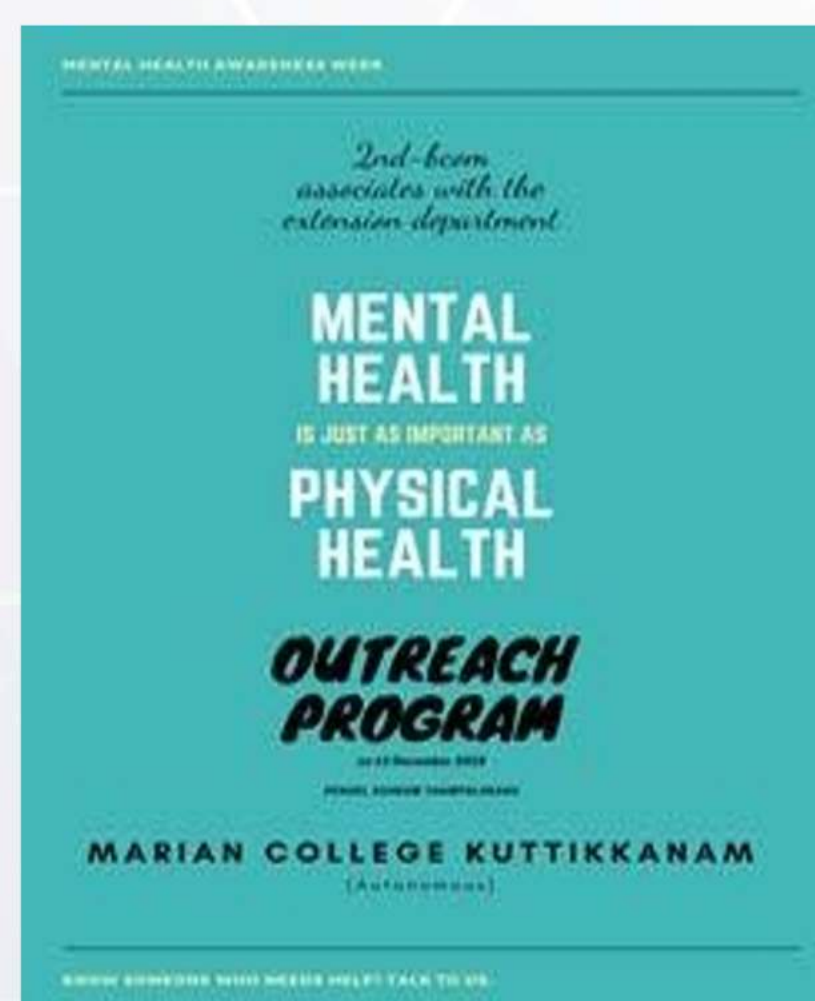

Thampalakadu(12/12/2018)**

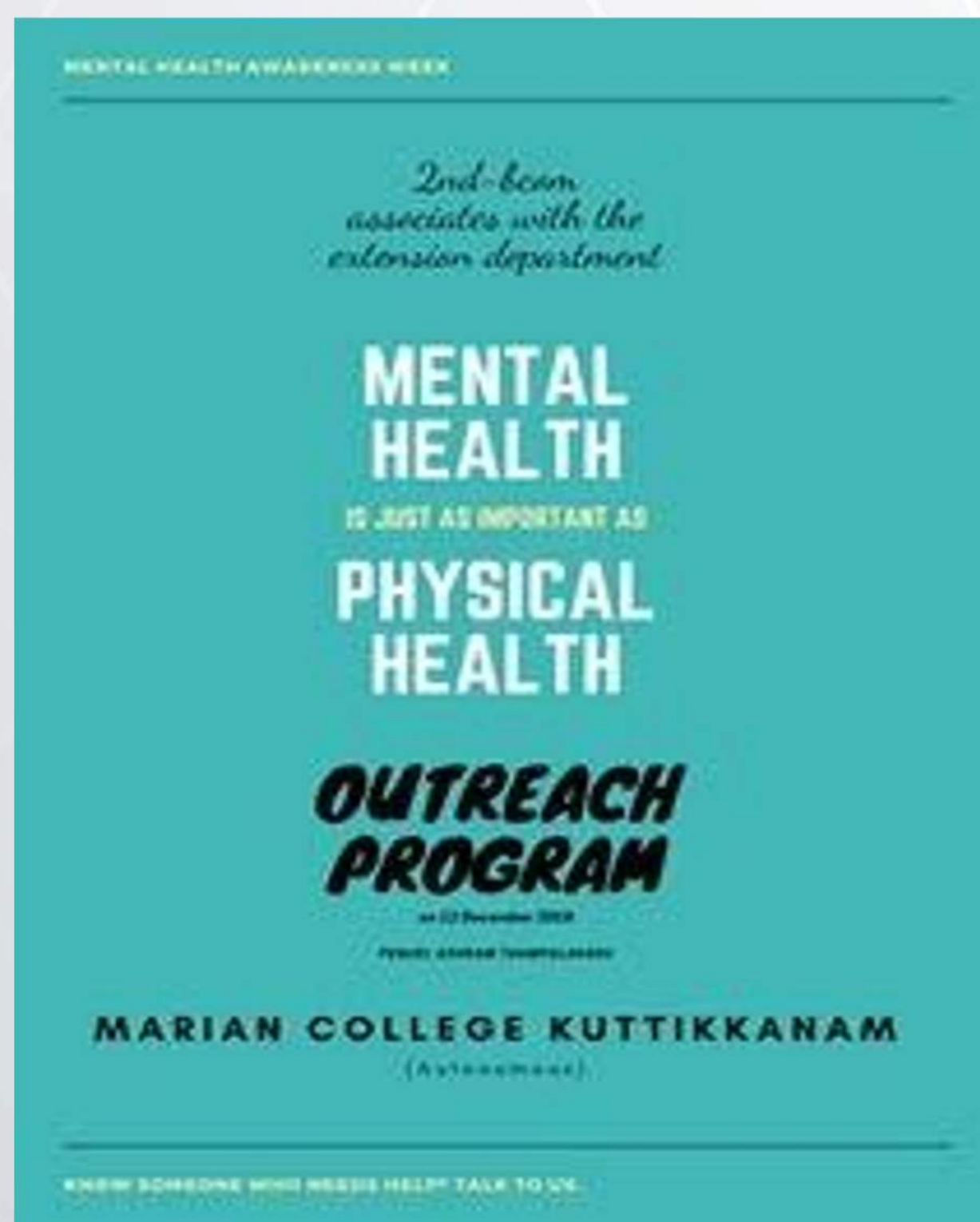

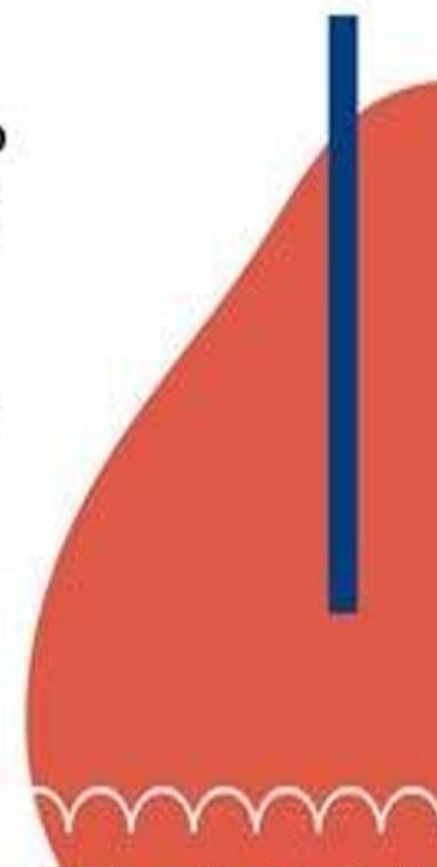

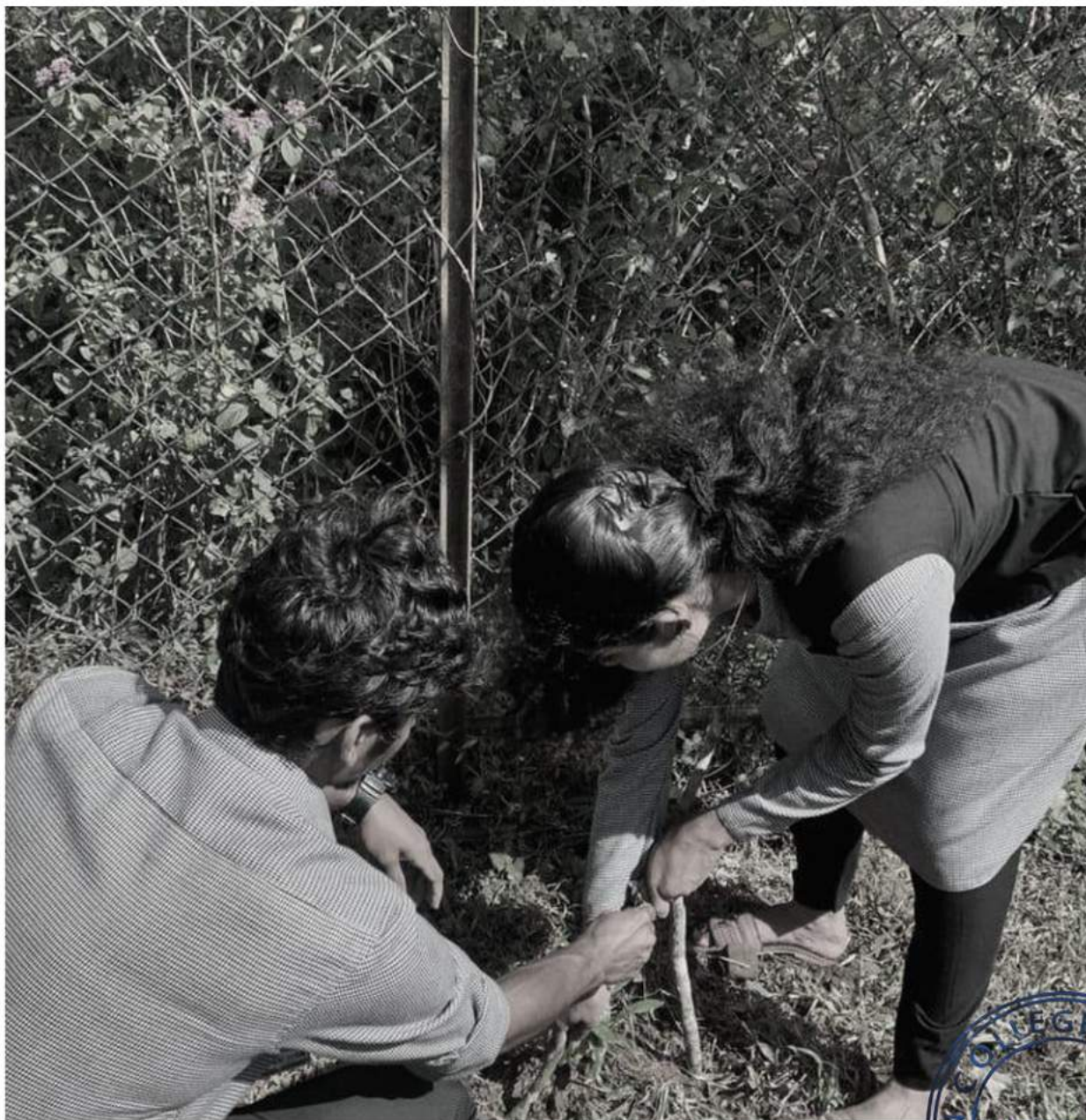

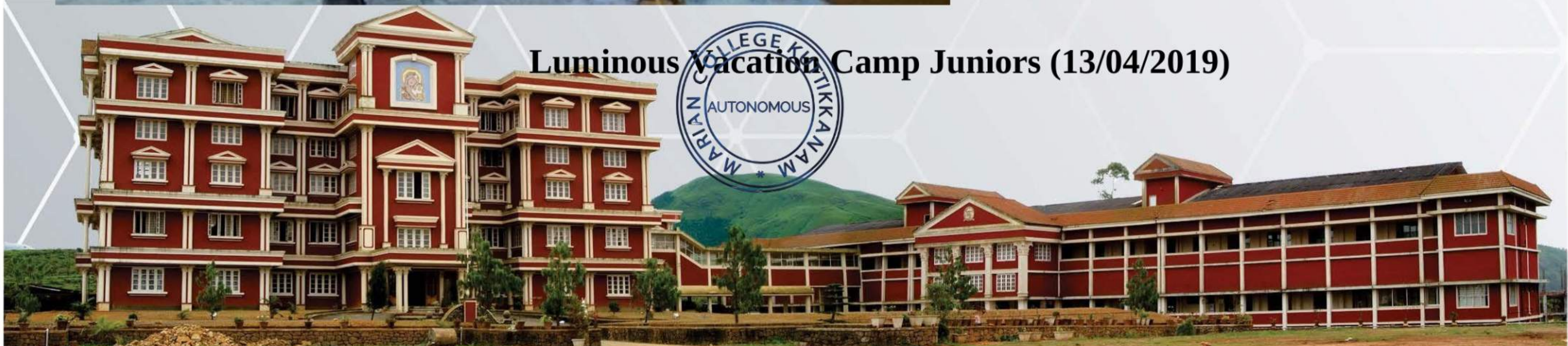
23. LUMINOUS VACATION CAMP-PERSONALITY AND SKILL DEVELOPMENT(JUNIOR)

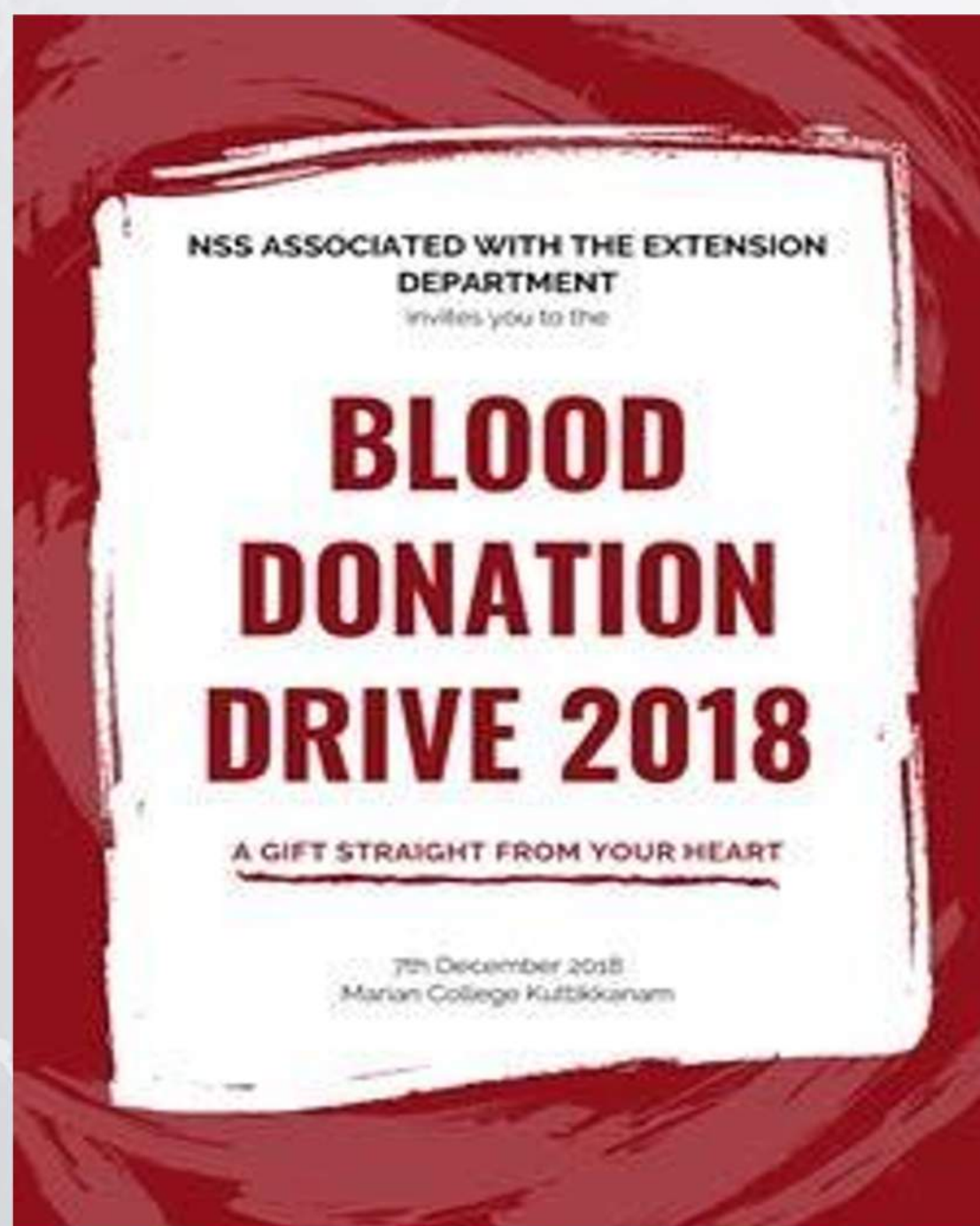

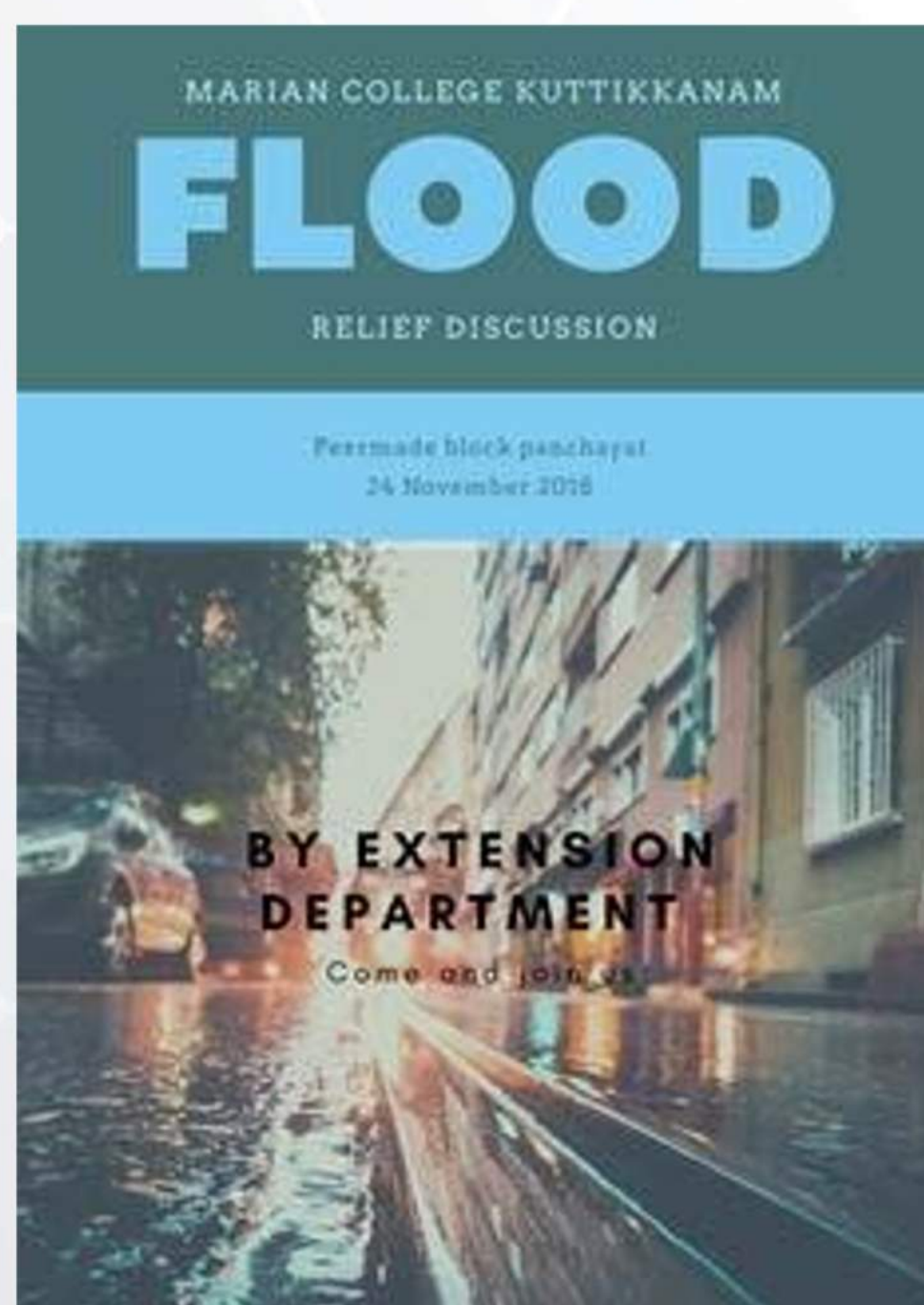



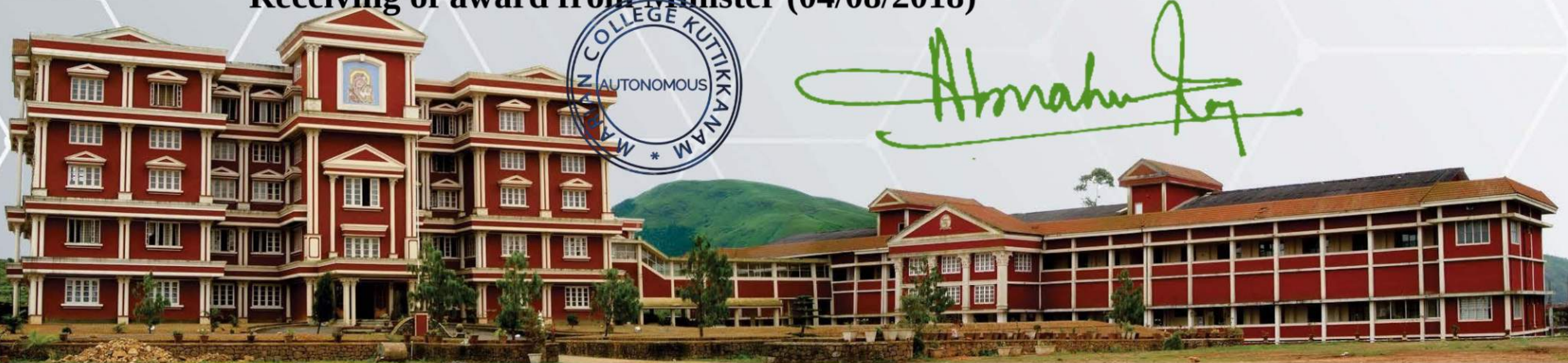

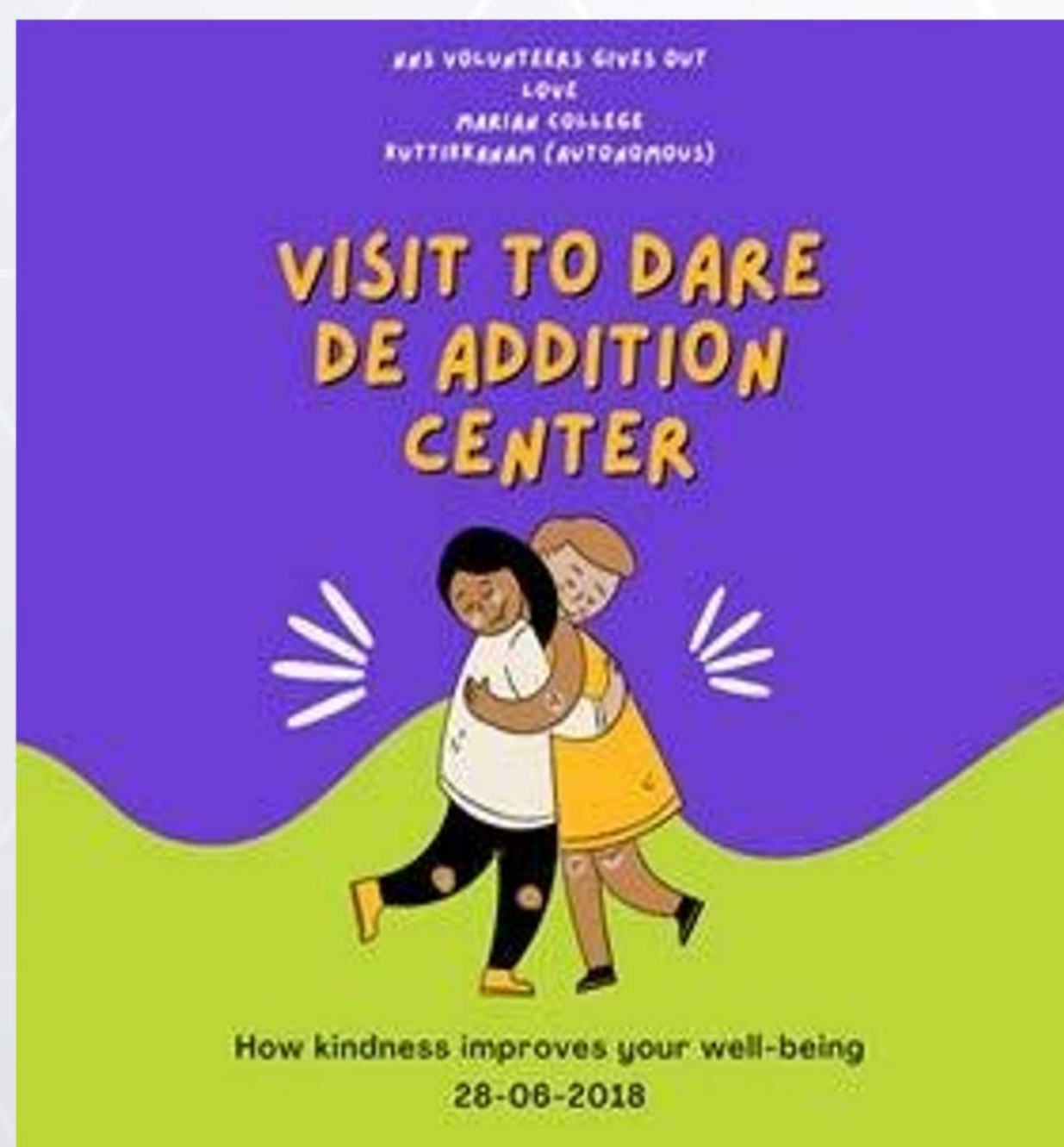

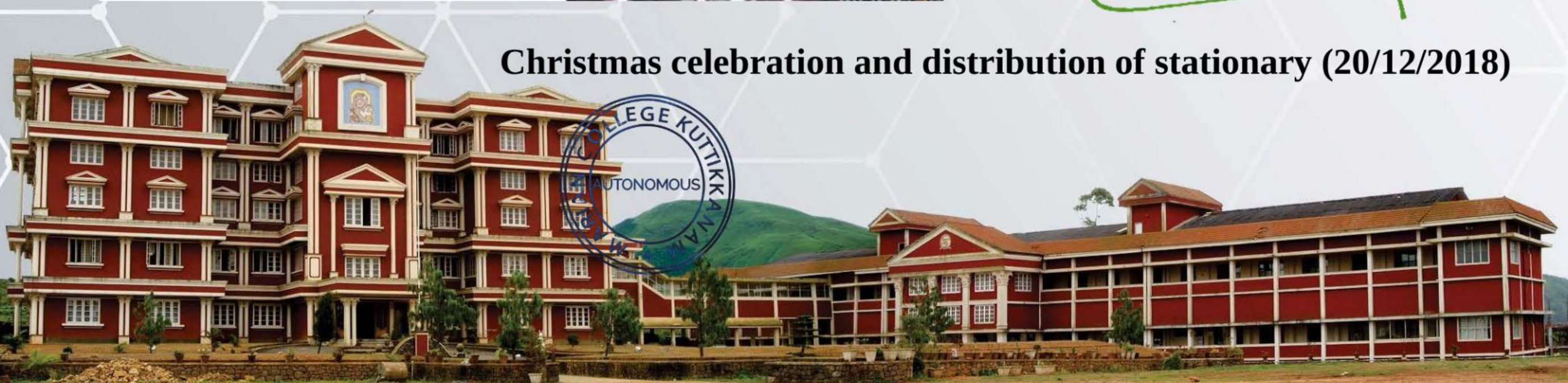
